#### Notes:

- Contributions were up for May. Individual contributions were up significantly from April at \$2400 and group contributions were up slightly at \$5714. We are still about \$14,000 below budget for the year to date on contributions
- The Gala ticket sales were \$6740 and Gala expenses were \$12,474. The platform we use for ticket sales sends the
  payments monthly so there is a delay of ticket sale money coming in. We are expecting an additional \$3700
  from ticket sales received in June, resulting in about a \$2k loss for the Gala.
- To ensure we meet our contributions budgeted for this year and can continue to provide planned services for the
