As I mentioned previously, I participate in an All Accessibility Committee (AAC) group that meets monthly. The group is made of members from around the country who are advocates for accessibility. Last month, the group heard a presentation by the Chicago Area Intergroup's Accessibility Committee about how to produce an accessible document, that is, one that complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). I have requested that Luella consider publishing the guidelines document in the digital New Reporter.

The next issue that I want to tackle is addressing the need for Spanish language meetings for women. I have purchased pamphlets from New York that address alcoholism and are printed in Spanish. I am in desperate need of someone who is Spanish literate to help me. I want to put the fliers out where women congregate, such as laundromats, but need someone who can field that calls that are generated. If you have this skill and are interested, please contact me.
